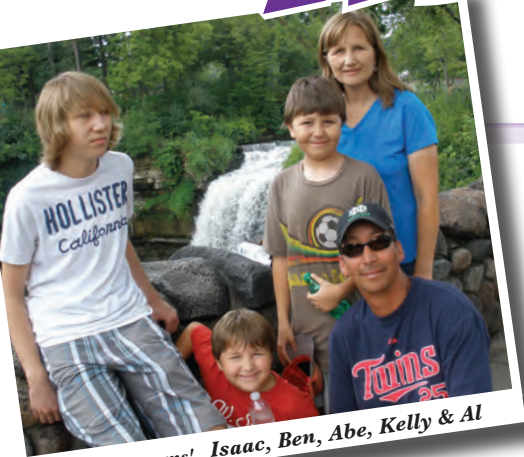


THE AMAZING ABE!
